## **ARCIC 1977**

With the provisional programme you will find various documents and journals; these are fully listed and numbered in the continuation catalogue. This includes Gunther Gassmann's consideration of Windsor, further comment on Venice (some of which was only published this month), a precis of the official report of the Church of England General Synod debate on Venice, and the usual Report on Anglican/Roman Catholic relations (with some attention to the Archbishop of Canterbury's visit to Pope Paul and the proposed Ordination of Women Consultation as well as a survey of national dialogues). There is also Bishop Howe's letter to Primates.

The Graymoor Prize money on the 28th July stood at £2,727; an increase of £225 on last year.
