You must feel free to make any use of this memo or not as you wish. I shall show or give copies to a restricted number of people.

If Michael Moore is coming to the BMU meeting at St Katherine's tomorrow and Thursday, and if you get this in time, could you please send by him the papers I lent you from the United States which I forgot to ask for in Versailles and Bishop Mabula's paper or a copy of this. I would of course return the original if it were that.
