p.5. line 2. This would be a possible point for a sentence to the effect that 'Anglicans do not characteristically <sup>however</sup> ~~it~~ 'it is not characteristic of Anglicans to' think religious certainty enhanced by a doctrine of papal infallibility', [(if the Commission thinks this observation worthy of inclusion. It certainly touches a point of substance to which we otherwise make no reference).]

p.5. para.2. line 1, would read better as 'Anglicans generally understand 'infallibility' as an absolute term....'

p.5. para.3. line 7. After 'with the faith' would the Commission consider adding 'They are confident that she was prepared by divine grace to be the mother of our Redeemer and that her glory in heaven is proportionate to the honour God gave her on earth'?
