We do not regard the subjects of the Statements as the only issues of importance, nor do we dispute that some will regard other matters as more important and place their main emphasis elsewhere. Those who treasure the insights and emphases of other traditions would rightly expect that these would be welcomed and shared as an enrichment of the common life of a visibly united church.
