The subjects which the Commission believed were its first priority to tackle happened to be matters concerning sacramental life and ministerial authority. This does not mean that they regard these matters as the only issues of importance or that they reject the position of those whose main emphasis would lie elsewhere. Those who treasure the insights and emphases of the Reformation tradition would rightly expect that these would be welcomed and shared as an enrichment of the common life of a reunited church. Ultimately, shared experience more than theological debate can ~~alone~~ bring full conviction that we are one in the same gospel of the grace of God, received through faith and issuing in a life of holiness and obedience.
