As the enclosed list shows, a number of Anglican-Roman Catholic Commissions have now been set up at national or provincial level in different parts of the world. As the Anglican Secretary to the Anglican/Roman Catholic International Commission I have recently been approached by some of them with requests for documents or material for study from A.R.C.I.C. or from other national commissions. This has prompted me to write, as I am now doing, to a correspondent in each of these commissions for two reasons. First, to inform you of the existence of similar groups in other countries. And second, to put to you the suggestion that it might be profitable if you could forward to the other national Anglican/Roman Catholic Commissions, as well as to me for the International Commission, any reports of your own meetings or other documents which you feel would be of value to your colleagues in other countries.

May I also add a reminder that at the next meeting of the International Commission at Windsor in September this year we shall be continuing our discussion of the three subjects of the now published "working papers" produced at Venice last year. Your own Commission's comments or criticisms of these will be eagerly welcomed by the International Commission, and can be passed on to them through me, preferably before the end of July. Copies of the Venice papers are also available from this office if you have been unable to obtain them from other sources.
