TO ALL MEMBERS OF ARCIC-II

I am now glad to be able to send you a clean copy of the final text from Durham (ARCIC-II 30/1 (84)), together with ARCIC-II 34 (84) "Comments on the Final Drafts from Durham". Other members are invited to send me any comments they may have.

At the same time I am enclosing the final section of ARCIC-II 22 (84) - Minutes of the Durham meeting - together with a "Continuation of the Catalogue of Papers"(ARCIC-II 14 (84)).

I am also taking the opportunity of sending other papers for members who had to leave before the end of the meeting, and copies of Anglican-Roman Catholic Marriage: The Report of the Anglican-Roman Catholic International Commission on the Theology of Marriage and its Application to Mixed Marriages for those who asked me for them.

Your Co-Secretaries will be meeting shortly, after consultation with the Co-Chairmen, over the work to be done before the next meeting.

I have been in discussion with Mary Tanner on matters to be commissioned in the light of the "Growth in Reconciliation" paper (ARCIC-II 33 (84)). There is also the most important matter of a sub-commission to work on ARCIC-II 30/1 (84).

I am hoping that your Co-Secretaries will be able to write next month about both these areas and any other matters mentioned in the course of the last ARCIC meeting which require work to be commissioned.
