The Commission met in Huntercombe Manor, whose history goes back 1,000 years to the reign of King Edward the Confessor. The house is now owned by the Buckinghamshire Education Committee and is used for residential courses. It contains a mediaeval hall built c.1340 and has a number of outstanding features, including much Jacobean panelling, and three painted ceilings by Antonio Verrio, and is surrounded by a garden of some ten acres.
