

GENERAL SYNOD

The Archbishop of Canterbury's correspondence with
leaders of other Churches on the Ordination of Women

Introduction

1. At the July 1976 group of sessions of the General Synod, the Archbishop of Canterbury answered a Question from Canon Paul Welsby about the nature of his contacts with other Church Leaders on the Ordination of Women, following the General Synod's debate on that subject in July 1975. In his Answer, the Archbishop referred to various letters, which were posted on a notice board for the convenience of Synod members.
