- 1. It is suggested that the groups work under the overall framework of "The Ecclesiology of Reconciliation" (cf ARCIC Final Report, Introduction, para. 8, last two sentences)
- 2. Within this framework: two groups are asked to work on the theme "Salvation and the Church" (taking up our discussion on Justification)

The other two groups are asked to work on the theme "Steps towards full communion" (taking up references to 'partial communion', ouestions concerning reconciliation of Churches and ministries, etc.)

- 3. The number of the discussions is not to draft agreed statements (:) but to set out the questions this Commission needs to discuss to suggest how we should set to work over these subjects
 - (a) over the next t elve months(b) long-term
 - to indicate any lines of convergence that have already emerged.
- 4. In the plenary sessions on Sunday/Monday the Commission will be asked on the basis of the groups' reports, to come to some conclusions and determine its priorities.
- 5. Each group is to prepare a <u>short</u> note of its recommendations etc; it would help the secretories to have this at some stage on Saturday evening.
